**Student Entertainment Events Presents: Dan Savage**

Student Entertainment Events, the Campus Coalition for Sexual Literacy, Tau Epsilon Phi Fraternity and the Pride Alliance are pleased to announce a lecture by sex columnist Dan Savage on Wednesday, Feb. 11. The event is free and will take place in the Grand Ballroom of the Adele H. Stamp Student Union-Center for Campus Life. Doors will open at 6:30 p.m. and the lecture will begin at 7 p.m.

Raised by Irish-Catholic parents in Chicago, Dan Savage's perspective as a gay American sex columnist is recognized by its frank and witty discussion of sexuality, and its hostility towards conservatives. "Savage Love," the column for which he is best known, debuted in the first issue of alternative Seattle newspaper *The Stranger* in 1991. The popularity of his column paved the way for his sex-advice contributions to other publications, as well as radio and television shows.

Savage is the author four books: *The Commitment: Love, Sex, Marriage, and My Family*, *Skipping Towards Gomorrah: The Seven Deadly Sins And The Pursuit Of Happiness In America*, *Savage Love: Straight Answers from America's Most Popular Sex Columnist*, and *The Kid: What Happened After My Boyfriend and I Decided to Go Get Pregnant*. He continues writing his column today, and now works as the editorial director of *The Stranger*. He is also active in theater, and directs plays under the name Keenan Hollahan.
