



Student Entertainment Events Frequently Asked Questions

I want to attend a SEE event and it's ticketed. Where do I purchase tickets?

Tickets are sold for our events at the Hoff Theater Ticket Office in the Adele H. Stamp Student Union. The Hoff Theater Ticket Office is located on the ground floor of the Stamp, around the corner from Chick-fil-A in the food court.

Can I buy tickets online?

Tickets are available for purchase online for certain shows. If that is the case, it will be advertised for the show. Please check our website for additional details.

While tickets might be on sale for an event at the Hoff Theater Ticket Office, online ticketing will start two (2) weeks from the event date. Please visit our website for the link to the online ticketing website.

How can I find out about SEE events?

Check out the SEE website at www.see.umd.edu. This website will always have the most up-to-date information about our events. Also, join our listserv! You can do that by submitting your email address on the homepage of the SEE website.

I am a part of a student group, and we would like to co-sponsor an event with SEE. What should we do?

There are two ways of co-sponsoring with SEE:

1. Contact the SEE Co-Sponsorship Director at SEECosponsorship@umd.edu. The SEE Co-Sponsorship Director oversees the SEE Review Board, which is a board that grants funding for diverse programming. The SEE Review Board is able to give money in support of a program after a proposal has been submitted. Let the Co-Sponsorship Director know about the program you are trying to plan and

they will provide you with additional information. You will then bring a proposal (application) to the SEE Review Board at the board meetings on Tuesdays at 7pm. Visit <http://www.see.umd.edu/srboard.php> for more information.

2. Contact the SEE Director related to the specific type of program you are interested in planning (i.e., a lecture event would go to the Lectures Director). Send them an e-mail explaining the event you have in mind or see what events they might have planned that you can co-sponsor. Are there paying jobs in SEE?

There are two paying jobs with SEE – the security team and technical team. Both jobs pay minimum wage.

The Security Team is run by the Security Director. They assist in securing different events. If interested, contact the Security Director at SEESecurity@umd.edu.

The Technical Team is run by the Technical Director. They assist in setting up and breaking down the stage, lights, etc. for the events. If interested, contact the Technical Director at SEETechnical@umd.edu.

How else can I get involved with SEE?

Another way to be involved with SEE is through the Marketing Team. The Marketing Team is run by the Marketing Director. They help to promote our events through chalking, flyering, and brainstorming creative marketing techniques. If interested, contact the Marketing Director at SEEMarketing@umd.edu.

If you are interested in programming and becoming a part of the SEE Executive Board, you can also become a SEE Director! Just fill out the application that will be made available on our website in early October. They will be due in early November. Descriptions of the different director positions can be found at <http://www.see.umd.edu/directors.php>. Director positions are a three (3) semester commitment—spring, fall, and spring.

Is there a way to get SEE tickets or other items as a promotional technique for my organization or office?
