He is most famous for his role as the on-air mentor to the designers on Bravo's reality television show "Project Runway," where his critical eye is highly valued in helping to make their projects work. The success from this show allowed him to start his own show on the same network, "Tim Gunn's Guide to Style," where he helps the fashion-challenged develop a sense of how to dress best for them. Rather than focusing on current trends, he channels their inner style and finds things that flatter their body types.

Aside from his television accomplishments, Tim Gunn has also excelled in other areas of the fashion world. In March 2007 he became the chief creative officer of Liz Claiborne, a well-known makeup company. In addition to this, Gunn co-wrote a book with Kate Moloney, entitled *A Guide to Quality, Taste, and Style*. It serves as an extremely comprehensive guide to style peppered with the wit and humor that have become trademarks of his speech. More recently, the city of Palm Desert honored him with an official resolution declaring April 27 (the day of his tour stop in their town) "Timothy M. Gunn Day" in recognition of his great achievements in the fashion world.
