As one of the longest-running cast members in the history of "Saturday Night Live", Tim Meadows found his stride on-stage after college, when he moved to Chicago to join the ImprovOlympia team and later the Second City troupe. It wasn't until 1991 when Meadows joined the cast of SNL as a feature player. Although he did little film or television work during his SNL years, Meadows was nominated for an Emmy in 1991. As his SNL career ended, he continued to grace the small screen with roles in sitcoms, such as "The Michael Richards Show" and "Leap of Faith".

Meadows continued his acting career in the 2000's, with memorable and comical roles in "The Evens Stevens Movie", "The Bench Warmers", "Mean Girls", as the high school principal suffering from carpal tunnel, and most recently in "Walk Hard: The Dewey Cox Story".
