Doors will open at 7 p.m. and the event will start at 8 p.m. in the Hoff Movie Theater in the Stamp Student Union. Lee entered the movie world in 1986 when he produced the independently produced, mostly black-and-white film "She's Gotta Have It." Not only did this movie do well at the box office, drew attention to him and his work.

Some of Lee's creations include "Malcolm X," "Bamboozled," "25th Hour" and "She Hate Me." His work expands to writing, directing and producing television movies, commercials and music videos.

Lee's most recent accomplishment, scheduled to air August 29, 2006, is a HBO documentary titled "When the Levees Broke: A Requiem in Four Acts." Lee shows the damage caused by Hurricane Katrina and includes footage of New Orleans as well as citizens who were directly affected by the hurricane.
