Student Entertainment Events is pleased to announce a night of comedy with Daniel Tosh on Tuesday, Nov. 27 in the Grand Ballroom of the Adele H. Stamp Student Union. Doors for this event will open at 7 p.m. and the event will start at 8 p.m. Tickets for this event are free with a UMID and \$10 for the general public. Students will not need tickets, but will need to present their UMIDs at the door. The general public can purchase tickets online at [www.see.umd.edu](http://www.see.umd.edu) and pick them up at the Hoff Ticket Office in the Stamp Student Union before the show, or can purchase them directly from the Hoff Ticket Office.

Tosh began his venture into stand-up comedy as a University of Central Florida business student. Known for his over-the-top material and casual presentation, Tosh trudges fearlessly on unclaimed and sometimes uncomfortable comedy-subject territory, poking fun at subjects like war and religion. Today, as one of the most requested headliners in the country, Tosh's relentless style has maintained popularity with his foundation audience, the college demographic, and he has performed at over 700 college campuses.

Tosh can also be recognized from his many television appearances, including performances on a variety of CBS and NBC late-night shows, VH-1's "The Best Week Ever" and FX's "The Test." Often featured on Comedy Central, in 2002 Tosh taped his first stand-up special, "Comedy Central Presents Daniel Tosh." He has also performed on the station's "Premium Blend," and "Friday Night Stand-Up." While still living in Florida, Daniel hosted his own popular late-night television show, "Tens."

An internationally acclaimed comedian, Tosh has also appeared in the New Faces segment at the Just for Laughs International Comedy Festival in Montreal. Because of the great response he received, he was invited to return two years later in his own televised Gala. In addition, Tosh has done festival performances in New Zealand and Kikenny, Ireland, one of Europe's largest comedy festivals.
