University of Maryland is pleased to announce the Adult Swim Tour featuring Ghostface Killah and Witchdoctor. The musical arts show will take place in the Grand Ballroom in the Adele H. Stamp Student Union on Sunday, Oct. 7, 2007 at 7:30 p.m. Doors for the event open at 7 p.m. and tickets are available at the Hoff Ticket Office in the Stamp Student Union. The even is free with a UMID and \$15 for the general public.

Dennis Coles, or Ghostface Killah, gained public recognition as one of the original members of the seminal '90's rap group, Wu-Tang Clan. The crew's success enabled each of its members to pursue solo careers and Ghostface had great momentum; he released 10 albums from 1996 to 2007 and has been featured on countless albums of fellow artists. He is praised for his free association lyrics and powerfully driven performances. He was named Ghostface because he used to perform with a mask on his face, prompting rumors that he was wanted by the police. Now, he is performing on the Rock the Bells tour along with Rage Against the Machine, Nas, and The Roots.

Erin Johnson, or Witchdoctor, is an established member of Atlanta's Dungeon Family collective along with Goodie Mob, OutKast, Killer Mike, and Big Rube, amongst others. He has released three solo albums, one mixtape, and one book (a collection of poetry and prose) from 1997 to 2006 and has also been featured on other artists' albums. *King of the Beasts* was his 2006 album and most recent contribution to the realm of hip-hop and spoken word.
