Student Entertainment Events Presents: The Colony Comedy Club featuring The Sklar Brothers!

The University of Maryland welcomes comedians Randy and Jason Sklar as part of the Stamp Student Unions Weekend of 1000 laughs, on Thursday February 23rd, 2006. The Sklar brothers will be the first performers to kick off the Student Entertainment Events Colony Comedy Club. Doors will open at 7 pm and the event will start at 8 pm in the Colony Ballroom of the Stamp Student Union. This event is free of charge.

The Sklar Brothers have been performing their comedy acts on shows such as "Late Night with Conan O'Brien," "The Late Late Show with Craig Kilbourne," "Premium Blend" on Comedy Central, and HBO's "Comedy Showcase with Louie Anderson." According to *The New York Times*, the pair is, "a tag team delivery in which one talks over the end of the other's sentence, completing, adding to or reaffirming his comment (much like the raps of The Beastie Boys)."

While they started performing in high school, it was not until 1996 when the brother duo were apart of a four-episode comedy show, "Double Agents," that their careers took off. This show, along with "Flamingo Lounge," helped to catch they eye of MTV talent executives who were looking to create a new kind of show.

It was at this point that the Sklar brothers created "Apartment 2F," a sitcom was based on Randy and Jason's experiences living in New York City. The show premiered on July 13, 1997 and got brilliant reviews, such as one from The Hollywood Reporter affirming that the Sklars' could be the Seinfeld of the late '90's.
