Student Entertainment Events is pleased to announce An Evening with Stephen Lynch on Wednesday May 9th. Doors for this event will open at 7:30 p.m. and the event will start at 8 p.m. in the Grand Ballroom in the Stamp Student Union. Inspired by the movie “This Spinal Tap,” Stephen Lynch began pursuing his career as a comedic singer and songwriter in 1996 in New York City. Endowed with a great voice and creativity, Lynch became locally well known for his hysterical lyrics and he began to tour the country. In 2000 he taped his own “Comedy Central Presents” special and released his first CD, “A Little Bit Special.”

Since releasing his first CD, Lynch has released “Superhero” in 2002 and “The Craig Machine” in 2005. Collectively they have sold over 250,000 copies. In 2005 these two albums were named two of the 100 best-selling independent albums in iTune’s history. Today, Lynch is starring in the new Broadway Musical, “The Wedding Singer,” for which he received a Tony Award nomination for Best Performance by a Leading Actor in a Musical, among other distinguished nominations.
